

Jezebel

The Jezebel spirit is the spirit that John writes about in the book of Revelation 2:20, The Lord states to the church at Thyatira this:

Revelation 2:20-21 New King James Version (NKJV)

²⁰ Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. ²¹ And I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent.

Now we know that Jezebel was not physically alive during this time in history, Therefore it is the spirit or the figure of this women and who she was that is alive and being tolerated.

Some clues to the behaviors and manifestations of Jezebel are:

- 1) She calls herself a prophetess; you more than likely will find her in prophetic ministry in the church.
- 2) She is a teacher but she is a false teacher. She espouses lies, which are contrary to the Word of God.
- 3) She is seductive: tempting and attractive; enticing. Some other words are, alluring, sexy, irresistible, exciting, and provocative.
- 4) She seduces God's servants to commit sexual immorality and eat thing sacrificed to idols. In other words she tells them it is okay to follow the worlds practices in the area of sexuality (homosexuality is acceptable, sex before marriage is acceptable, marriage is just a piece of paper and so on.) Things sacrificed to idols, means it's okay to disobey the way of the Lord. She will follow the Christian Fads and chase after "New Revelation", not biblical revelation.
- 5) God gave her room to repent and she did not, she is unteachable and unreachable.

This draws us back to the Old Testament origins of Jezebel. We are introduced to Jezebel in 1 Kings 18:4, she is the wife of Ahab who massacred the prophets of the LORD.

- 6) She kills God's prophets – She hates those who have the Word of the LORD, preachers, teachers and prophets, the people of God.

1 Kings 18:19 – There are 450 prophets of Baal and four hundred prophets of Asherah who eat at Jezebel's table.

7) These 850 false prophet's are Jezebel's children.

1 Kings 17, ²⁸ So they cried aloud, and cut themselves, as was their custom, with knives and lances, until the blood gushed out on them.

8) She asks for sacrifice to the God Baal, by cutting themselves, self-mutilation.

1 Kings 19:2, ² Then Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah, saying, "So let the gods do *to me*, and more also, if I do not make your life as the life of one of them by tomorrow about this time." ³ And when he saw *that*, he arose and ran for his life, and went to Beersheba, which *belongs* to Judah, and left his servant there.

9) Jezebel sends messages through messengers to scare and harass the people of God.

1 Kings 19:4 "It is enough! Now, Lord, take my life, for I *am* no better than my fathers!"

10) 1 Kings 19:4 she causes depression and couple with self-mutilation in 1 Kings 17:28, you find she is mentality ill and mental illness surrounds her.

1 Kings 21:1-16. Ahab wants the vineyard that is close to his house for a vegetable garden, he asks Naboth if he would sell it to him or if he could replace it with an even better one and Naboth refused because it is the land of his forefathers and he wants it. Naboth sulks around and Jezebel asks what is wrong, so Ahab tells her the story. So Jezebel devises a plan to have Naboth killed through deceit and take his land.

11) Jezebel will do whatever it takes to get her way, she will kill if necessary, she will lie and manipulate those around her to do her bidding.

1 Kings 21:23-24

²³ And concerning Jezebel the Lord also spoke, saying, 'The dogs shall eat Jezebel by the wall of Jezreel.' ²⁴ The dogs shall eat whoever belongs to Ahab and dies in the city, and the birds of the air shall eat whoever dies in the field."

12) Jezebel will be destroyed by the LORD!

1 Kings 21:25

But there was no one like Ahab who sold himself to do wickedness in the sight of the Lord, because Jezebel his wife stirred him up.

13) She stirs up people to do evil toward God.

2 Kings 9:7

You shall strike down the house of Ahab your master, that I may avenge the blood of My servants the prophets, and the blood of all the servants of the Lord, at the hand of Jezebel.

14) She murders not only the prophets but the servants of the Lord.

2 Kings 9:10

¹⁰The dogs shall eat Jezebel on the plot *of ground* at Jezreel, and *there shall be none to bury her.*”

15) God seals her fate, she will be destroyed.

Joram the son of Jezebel asks the prophet Jehu have you come in peace? He answers:

“What peace, as long as the harlotries of your mother Jezebel and her witchcraft *are so many?*”

16) Jezebel is a harlot and uses witchcraft.

2 Kings 9:30

Jezebel's *Violent [Death]* Now when Jehu had come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard *of it*; and she put paint on her eyes and adorned her head, and looked through a window.

17) She has a false persona, (put on a face) she is not what she seems and until the end she will seduce and deceive.

Jezebel is thrown to her death by three eunuchs who served her. And God fulfilled the prophesy the dogs ate her all that was left was her skull, feet and palms of her hands, which they did not bury. There is not worldly marker of a plot for Jezebel.
